Thank you for your request for information received at Northampton General Hospital NHS Trust (NGH) on 11/06/2019.

I am pleased to be able to provide you with the following information:

- 1. The percentage of patients who have died on the Trust's end-of-life care plan against the Trust's target for the number of patients who should die on this plan over the last three years, divided by the year.
 - o e.g. Between 1 January 2016 and 31 December 2016, 43 per cent of patients died on the plan against a target of 35 per cent.
 - o Note: If no such target exists, please make this clear.

These figures are available for the last two years:

Between 1st April 2017 and 31st March 2018, 61% of patients died on the Dying Persons Care Plan against a target of 50%

Between 1st April 2018 and 31st March 2019, 60% of patients died on the Dying Persons Care Plan against a target of 60%

The target was increased from 50% to 60% to reflect the achievement in the previous year

- 2. The amount received by the Trust, via the Commissioning for Quality and Innovation (CQUIN) system or similar, for hitting targets related to its end-of-life care plan for the last three years, divided by the year.
 - o e.g. Between 1 January 2016 and 31 December 2016, the Trust received £X via CQUIN for achieving goals involving its ICP.
