Thank you for your request for information received at Northampton General Hospital NHS Trust (NGH) on 21/06/2019.

I am pleased to be able to provide you with the following information:

- 1. Does your Trust use pen and paper to build patient records? If so, in which departments? Yes, the trust still uses hand written information. Whilst a number of clinical systems are in place to capture patient information, there are still a variety of paper forms completed by hand. Examples of paper forms still in use; nursing notes, deteriorating patient treatment plans, business continuity for the Trust continues to include paper forms in case of power cuts.
- 2. Does your Trust use analogue tape dictation to record patient encounters? If so, in which departments?
 - All departments use digital dictation devices linked to the Trusts' central voice recognition solution.
- 3. Who in the Trust is responsible for digitising paper records?

 Head of Clinical Systems responsible for electronic clinical systems and the Medical Records department, which includes paper as well as electronic patient records management.
