According to the NHS Trust guidelines, at what PSA level should GPs refer patients for suspected prostate cancer?

- Does this differ depending on any factor, such as age?
- Are repeated PSA tests required before a referral?

When were the NHS Trust prostate cancer referral guidelines last updated?
