When you arrive at the X-Ray department, the receptionist will ask you for your name.



You will be asked to sit in the waiting room. The waiting room may be busy.



You may be taken to a changing room and asked to put on a hospital gown.



You will need to take off your jewellery.



The Radiographer will take you into the room for your X-Ray.

The Radiographer will tell you where to stand...

...or sit...

...or lie down. The X-Ray will not hurt.



The Radiographer will go behind a screen and they will talk to you.



Once the X-Ray is finished you will go back to the cubicle where you can get dressed.



You can put your jewellery back on.



You can now go home. The hospital will send the results to your doctor.
