Unfortunately we are unable to provide you with the information requested as:

Section 12(1) of the FOIA is a provision which allows a public authority to refuse to comply with a request for information where the cost of compliance is estimated to exceed a set limit known as the appropriate limit.

We can confirm that the amount of time required to extract and provide the information for all investigations over a five year period requested would exceed the 18 hours permitted for an individual FOI request. This is because the supporting files would have to be manually searched.
