We do not have any Thyroid patients on our Somerset database within that time frame being treated with chemotherapy. We have 9 Thyroid cancer patients, of these 9 all of them were Non- medullary but only 3 of these were diagnosed as differentiated. Of these 3 patients none were treated with the drugs listed, they would have received Brachytherapy or RI-131.
