Thank you for your request for information received at Northampton General Hospital NHS Trust (NGH) on 19/07/17 and I am pleased to be able to provide you with a response.

1. For the financial year 2016-17- I would like the total number of "serious untoward incidents" recorded at the trust, I would also like the total number of "never events" (or similar) recorded at the trust.

We had 15 serious incidents reported one of which was a never event.

2. For the 2016/17 financial year, I would like a breakdown containing details of each serious untoward incident and never event. The breakdown should include a description of what happened, an indication of whether the patient suffered harm and if so, the extent of the harm, as well as the name of the hospital where it happened.
